Single-Parent Students entering our program must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a single parent
- Have a child or children under 18 in the home; or be pregnant
- Meet low-income housing requirements
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Have the desire to pursue a college degree

Participants will be required to:

- Remain enrolled in college full time
- Maintain a 2.0 grade point average
- Contribute service hours through volunteer activities in the community.
