WEATHERIZATION



WEATHERIZATION AND HOME REPAIR SERVICES

Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission has been providing award-winning and research-based weatherization services and home repairs for over 40 years. The Weatherization Assistance Program is a part of the nation's largest and oldest residential energy efficiency network.

HOME EVALUATION

Trained inspectors with state-of-the-art equipment evaluate each home and create a list of repairs intended to reduce the cost of energy for the family.

A typical home evaluation:

- Tests furnaces and major appliances for gas leaks, carbon monoxide, safety, and energy efficiency.
- Determines air leak sources that need to be sealed or insulation installed.
- Identifies minor repairs that will improve health and safety along with improving energy efficiency.

COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES

NKCAC's Weatherization team provides a comprehensive range of services. The work is performed by highly trained and certified HVAC and Weatherization professionals. Services often include:

- Sealing air infiltration points, install insulation, and add ventilation
- Tuning, repairing, or replacing certain appliances
- Installing smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Providing energy efficient lighting
- Making allowable minor repairs to homes to improve the family's health and safety

EDUCATION

Homeowners are often looking for ways to reduce their energy usage and lower their heating, cooling and utility costs. Throughout the weatherization process, staff share ideas and information with homeowners about energy efficiency improvements they can make in addition to services they may receive through the Weatherization Program.



HOME REPAIR SERVICES

For eligible homeowners in Northern Kentucky aged 60 and older, NKCAC can help with immediate home repairs to keep the residents' home safe. Repairs include adding or repairing hand rails, adding grab bars in bathrooms, fixing floors to prevent tripping, or repairing other issues in a home that could cause injury.
