YouthBuild of Northern Kentucky is designed to serve financially challenged individuals between the ages of 16-24 without a high school diploma and not attending school. Participants must have a desire to work toward their GED and learn construction skills by building/renovating affordable housing for low income families. Strong emphasis is placed on leadership development and community service. Participants must be willing to accept the program requirements, including attendance for all program components.

- You will be paid while you work toward and obtain your G.E.D.
- You will be paid while you develop sound work habits, decision-making, and time management skills.
- Staff will assist you in selecting and pursuing career pathways to prepare for you vocational school and/or a college education or a career after YouthBuild..
- You will have the opportunity learn career planning and job interview skills.
- You will be paid while you earn your Carpentry and Construction Safety Certifications.
- You will be paid while you contribute to your community through community service projects.
- Counseling and referrals will be offered to address issues such as childcare, transportation, and substance abuse. Group and individual counseling are also incorporated in the YouthBuild curriculum.
